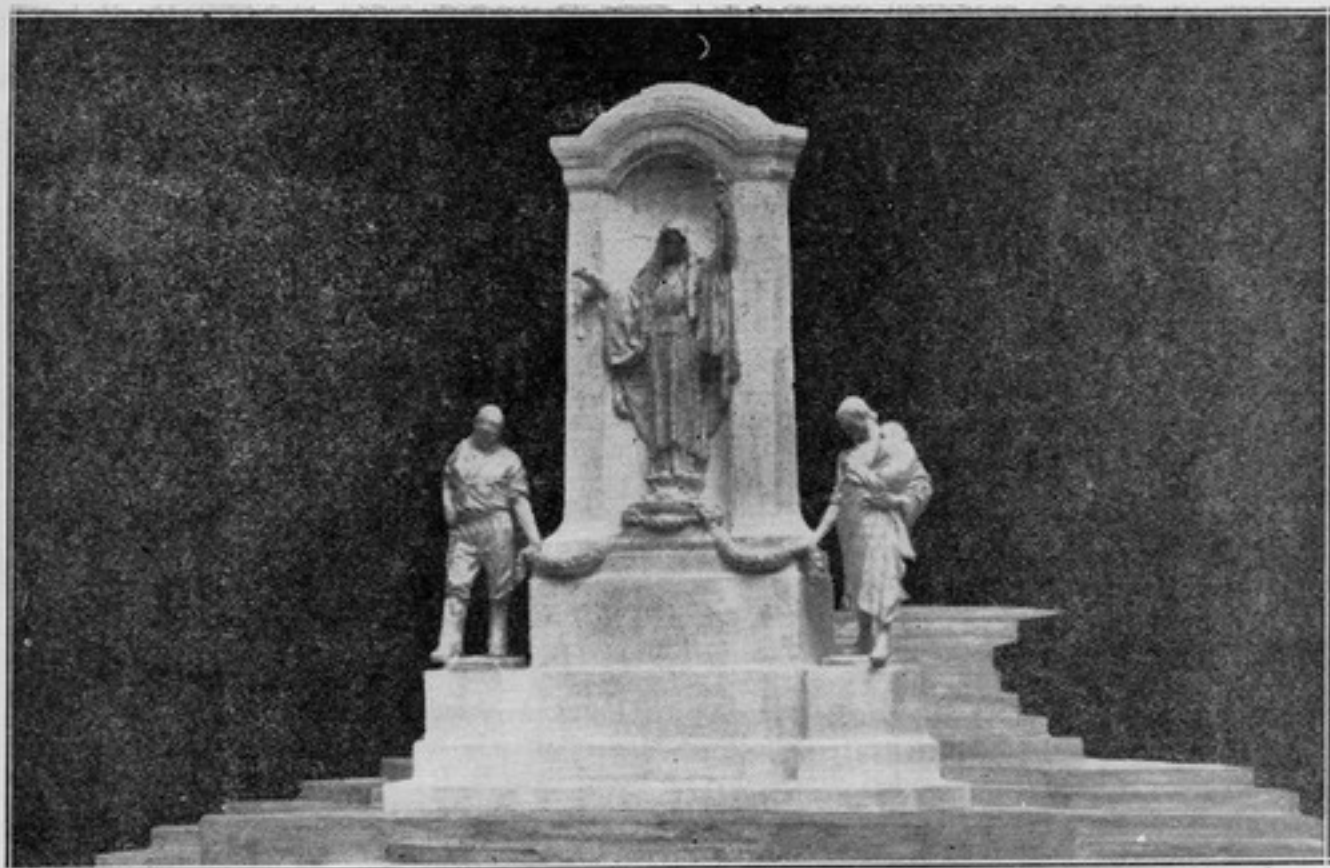

DESCRIPTION OF MEMORIAL

The design represents an apsidal screen with flanking pedestals of Portland stone carrying in the centre a life-size bronze figure of St. Tydfil standing on a base which bears a helmet and crossed swords and ornamented with rams' heads and garlands representing an altar of sacrifice. The bronze life-size statues of a miner and a woman with a baby on either side holding the garlands share the sacrifice while paying tribute to those who died and to those who were maimed bodily and mentally in the war. The Memorial is approached by a long flight of Radiating Steps of local greystone, the lower approach being protected by bronze rail and chain. The height of the Portland stone portion of the Memorial is 15ft. 9in., and this portion stands on a sub-base and platform about 12ft. above the level of the promenade.

HISTORY of MEMORIAL MOVEMENT

ALTHOUGH the inhabitants of the Borough had soon after the termination of hostilities signified their deep sense of gratitude for the victorious end of the great struggle by raising the large sum of £15,000, which was devoted to giving much needed aid to the Widows and Dependants of the Fallen, still, a strong feeling remained that some permanent form of memorial should be erected to remind future generations that this town had not failed to render the fullest aid to the Country in its hour of need. This culminated at last in a meeting being called by the then Mayor, Alderman Chas. Griffiths, on Thursday, November 30th, 1922, when a General Committee was formed to advance the project and consider what form it should take; and finally an Executive Committee was appointed to issue an Appeal for support and to carry the scheme to a conclusion. This Appeal, headed as it was by the munificent donation of £1,000 by the late Lord Buckland, gradually reached the sum of £2,667 (including interest). This sum being inadequate to meet more ambitious proposals which were discussed, it was decided to concentrate on a War Memorial to be erected on a suitable site. A site which commended itself to all, and which it was considered would be available, was a piece of ground forming part of the Castle Field, which it was hoped the Corporation would be enabled to acquire. Unfortunately, although the Committee was buoyed up with hope and encouraged to wait for several years, permission to acquire this land was not granted. Considerable difficulty was then experienced in selecting a satisfactory site, and eventually, one in Cyfarthfa Park and the present one at Pontmorlais, which had been offered for the purpose, were considered by the General Committee. Owing mainly to its remoteness, the site at Cyfarthfa Park was rejected by a majority in favour of the site at Pontmorlais, generously given by the owners of the Bolgoed Estate. This site has a commanding position at the junction of the roads to Dowlais and Cefn, and affords a good view of the completed Memorial from three different approaches.

Mr. L. S. Merrifield, of Chelsea, the celebrated Sculptor, had meanwhile been approached and had undertaken the commission; he proposed several designs, and finally the modified scheme of memorial, now completed, was approved. Mr. Merrifield had already gained favour with the townspeople by his small, but charming memorial erected at the Intermediate School. Another work which has won universal praise and is well known to inhabitants of Wales is "Williams of Pantycelyn" in the group of statuary at the City Hall, Cardiff. He also modelled a statue of Trevethick, which, but for the death of the late Lord Rhondda would have been erected in Merthyr. He has erected many memorials in various parts of the Country, and the Committee believe that the Merthyr Memorial will come to be regarded as one of his most successful efforts.
